- Courses listed under 'other options' do not have an equivalent course between institutions, but may still be used to satisfy the CORE requirement at Northwest.
- East Central College courses marked with (*) are listed under two different CORE categories. They may transfer to satisfy only one of Northwest's CORE areas, not both.
- Some courses listed may also have direct equivalents to major-specific courses. These courses may be used as a CORE requirement or a major requirement if applicable, but not both.
