

TRANSFER AGREEMENT

A formal partnership between Drury University and East Central College streamlines the path to a four-year degree for business and education students in eastern Missouri.

ECC students who have completed an Associate of Arts in Business or an Associate of Arts in Teaching will transfer seamlessly to Drury GO as juniors.

Students must meet Drury admissions standards. In addition to the following classes, students must complete 36 hours of 300- and 400-level coursework; 124 hours of total coursework is required for a bachelor's degree.
