

Canvas Online Learning System

- This tutorial serves as an introduction to Canvas, ECC's online learning system.
- You will use your ECC student email address to log in to Canvas along with the same password you use for your student email and eCentral.
- The majority of your online courses will be through the Canvas system. Some courses may use publisher websites as well.
- Even if you aren't taking online courses, many of your courses will likely use the Canvas system for online resources and more.
- Please contact the ECC Canvas/Online Learning Helpdesk if you have any questions or need help with any issues. It is critical that you notify your instructor or the Canvas Helpdesk as soon as issues appear.
