



What is the rootEd Community College Transfer Scholarship?

The rootEd Community College Transfer Scholarship is a renewable scholarship awarded to students transferring *from* eligible community colleges in Missouri to four-year colleges and universities. It is a **need-based** award of up to \$10,000 per academic year and is renewable through graduation, provided the student continues to meet eligibility and selection criteria.

The rootEd Community College Transfer Scholarship which will make **a select number of renewable scholarship awards** to students transferring *from* the following community colleges:

East Central College
Ozarks Technical Community College
State Fair Community College
Three Rivers Community College

To be eligible to be considered for this scholarship you must:

- Be a student transferring from an eligible community college, with plans to continue education at a bachelor's degree granting institution;
- Have graduated from a rural Missouri high school in the past five years;
- Plan to attend full-time at an accredited, nonprofit college or university;
- Have earned a minimum 2.0 cumulative grade point average;
- Demonstrate financial need, as determined by the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or similar need calculations*;
- Complete the application between January 1st and April 15th by visiting <https://stlouisgraduates.academicworks.com/opportunities/3356>.

To be considered, completed applications and all required supporting documents must be submitted by April 15. Awards will be announced in early June.
